

**Ninth International Conference
“Function Spaces, Differential Operators
and Nonlinear Analysis”**

Prague, Czech Republic, July 4–9, 2016

First Announcement

The ninth conference, which continues the series of eight conferences organized by the Institute of Mathematics CAS and Charles University (together with University of Jena and University of Helsinki), will take place at Prague from Sunday, July 3 (the day of arrival), to Saturday, July 9, 2016. The scientific programme will start on Monday morning, July 4, and will end at noon on Saturday, July 9.

2. Conference site

The conference will take place at the Faculty of Mathematics and Physics of the Charles University at Malostranské náměstí 25, in the historical centre of Prague. The conference room S3 is situated on the third floor.

3. Conference fee

The conference fee for a regular participant is CZK 4500. A reduced rate of CZK 4000 will be offered provided that the payment is made before April 30, 2016. The conference fee is reduced by 20% to 3600 (resp. 3200 for early payment) for the registered participant of the European Congress of Mathematicians.

The conference fee includes scientific and social programme (including excursion) and one copy of abstracts of lectures. It does not include board and lodging.

4. Board and lodging

Accommodation will be organized only for invited speakers. Other participants are kindly asked to arrange for their accommodation. We do not organize meals except for social dinner. There is a large choice of restaurants in the close neighbourhood.
